94% of females taking testosterone experience pelvic floor dysfunction.

In a study [1] of 68 women taking testosterone, 94.1% had some form of pelvic floor dysfunction. 86.7% had urinary symptoms. Other problems included storage symptoms (69.1%), sexual dysfunction (52.9%), anorectal symptoms (45.6%), and flatal incontinence (39.7%.)
